

Message from the Live Oaks Hurricane committee:

Dear neighbors,

The Hurricane committee wants you to be aware of emergency hurricane evacuation plans that would affect Live Oaks Community in the event of a Category 3 or higher hurricane. Live Oaks is considered a Zone 1 area because we live in manufactured homes.

Category 3 or higher would trigger the need to install hurricane shutters on the clubhouse and evacuation of our community. If you don't evacuate, you can shelter in the clubhouse at your own risk. Any pets would need to be crated and taken to the Hot Tub room. Remember to bring pet food.

If you are in need of help to secure your property before the storm, you can notify any member of the Hurricane Committee to coordinate assistance.

If you plan to evacuate and you use any powered medical devices, you should call ahead to motels/hotels to find out ahead of time if they have backup power in case of power outages. The clubhouse does not have generators to power any medical equipment.

There are additional hurricane preparedness suggestions posted over the mailboxes.
